The Audition

The audition will take Place on the 22nd March from 2pm - 5pm at the Talisman Theatre.

We are looking for a Drummer, Bass Guitarist, Rhythm Guitarist (Guitar 2), Lead Guitarist (Guitar 1) and Keyboardist.

We will ask you to play one prepared piece of music from the show. We would like you to learn and perform the Noise/Paradise/Good time song which is the opening for the show. The link to the score is at the bottom of the PDF.

We are looking for accuracy, performance and Feel.

We would also like you to prepare something else that shows off your musical talent and skill.

I will provide a guitar amp and jack lead but I advise you bring your own as you will need to do so for the show.

- Bass Guitar and Bass Amp (for Bass audition)
- Electric Guitar (for both Guitar 1 + 2 audition)
- Keyboard (for Piano audition)
